

TRiO

The TRIO Programs were originally established by the federal government in 1965 to ensure equal educational opportunity for all Americans, regardless of race, ethnic background, or economic circumstance.

These programs are distinguishable through their one-on-one aspect, focus on early intervention targeting First Generation and Low-Income students. Two of their TRIO Programs, Talent Search and Upward Bound are early intervention TRIO programs that help students in grades 6-12 with college potential explore their academic and career options. Programs under TRIO are community-based and funded by clear evidence that the program is needed in a particular community or town.

TRIO PROGRAM IMPACTS



TARGETED OUTREACH & SUPPORT

TRIO programs actively identify and reach out to students from low-income families who might not otherwise consider college, providing them with tailored support to navigate the academic and application process.



COMPREHENSIVE SERVICES

Beyond academic tutoring, TRIO programs offer academic tutoring, mentoring, career counseling, financial aid guidance, and workshops to address various challenges students face and other supports necessary for educational access and retention.



PROVEN SUCCESS RATE

Studies demonstrate that TRIO participants are significantly more likely to enroll in and graduate from college compared to their peers from similar backgrounds.



COMMUNITY IMPACT

By increasing college attainment within low-income communities, TRIO programs contribute to a more educated workforce and improved socioeconomic outcomes.



INCREASED COLLEGE RETENTION

By offering academic tutoring, counseling, mentoring, and personalized support, TRIO programs significantly improve student retention and graduation rates.

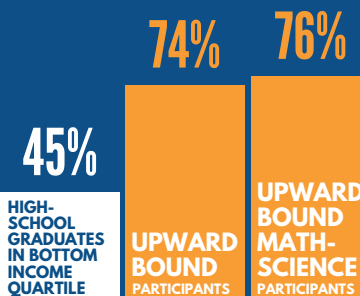

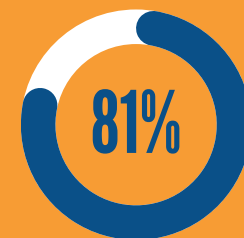

Upward Bound

The program helps high school students from low-income families or families without a bachelor's degree succeed academically, with the goal of increasing high school graduation rates and college enrollment and completion.

Upward Bound Math & Science

The program strengthens students' math and science skills, aiming to help them excel in these subjects and pursue postsecondary degrees and careers in math and science.

Talent Search

The program identifies and assists individuals from disadvantaged backgrounds, offering academic, career, and financial counseling to help them graduate high school and pursue and complete postsecondary education.
